### **Comments of 4 Professional Institutes on the Study on Lantau Tomorrow**

Thank you very much for your letter dated 1 April 2019, providing support to the studies on the artificial islands near Kau Yi Chau and the related major transport infrastructure (the Study); and offering valuable insights into all facets of Lantau Tomorrow, from its vision, public engagement activities, technologies to be adopted, methods of engaging consultancies, financial arrangements to impacts on climate, etc.

We share with you that Lantau Tomorrow is an opportunity to overcome the current spatial constraints and problems of congestions, as well as the degrading urban environment. 
Your letter together with the individual letters of the institutes have been relayed to CEDD. They shall carefully consider the professional views set out in the
