Case Study: a 20 A4 pages (double-side printed) case study, font size 12, including diagrams and photographs, to illustrate the applicant's understanding of urban design principles, in relation to spatial planning, place making, implementation process, as well as robustness in response to temporal and other changes over time. The subject of study should be one that contributes to the substantial urban design experience of the applicant. The contents may be asked during interview.

Professional Induction Workshop: a short course, ranging from 1-3 days and held every 6 months or at durations as determined by the HKIUD. The purpose is to set a benchmark for common understanding of urban design practice. There will be an assessment at the end of the course to ensure the understanding is achieved, in order to satisfy the threshold for recommendation to the interview.

Interview: The applicant will be interviewed by a panel of 3 nominated members by HKIUD Council, for a session of about 30 minutes, on the understanding of urban design principles and practice experience, to ensure that the applicant is suitable to become a HKIUD member.
