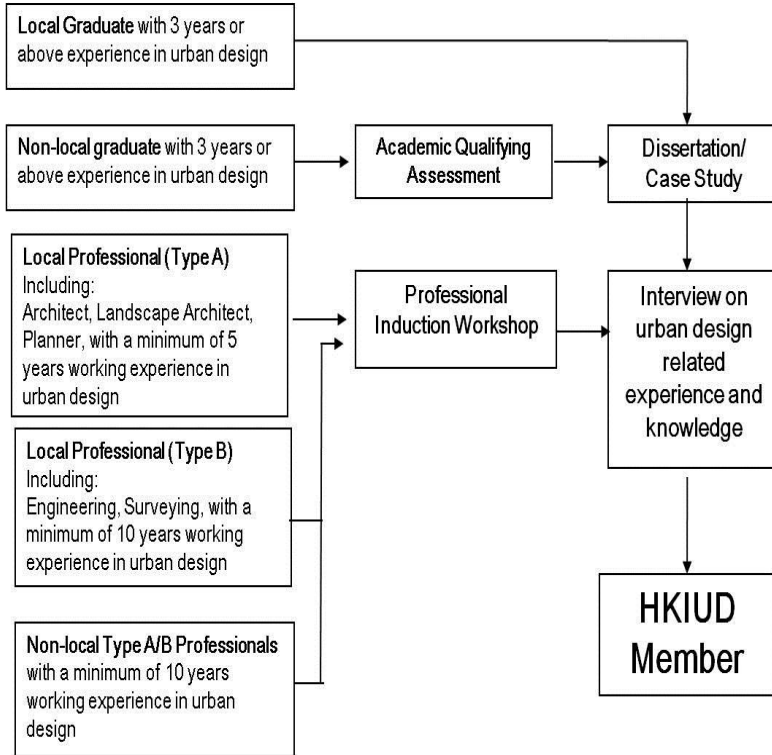

**Full Member Admission Criteria**



**Professional Induction Workshop:**

- (fee to be charged)
- Tailor-made programme by HKIUD, may be entrusted to other institutions
- Content and Passing Exam to be determined by HKIUD from time to time

**Academic Qualifying Assessment:**

- (by HKIUD, may be entrusted to other institutions)
- To be sat by non-local urban design graduates

**Interview:**

- As required, during initial stage of HKIUD set-up
- 1 chairman + 2 examiners, all must be HKIUD members, to be appointed by Council

**Experience:**

- To be certified by person directly related to the project, with notes of declaration that the information provided is of his/her personal knowledge.
- Detailed breakdown to be stated in the application form, on the role, % time, aspects (design, management, technical support, supervision) which may be questioned during interview

**Dissertation/ Case Study**

- Maximum of 20 printed A4 pages, of point 12 font, and maximum of 500 words per page, inclusive of diagrams and images, as well as names and titles on front page.

**Full Members**

To be eligible to become a Full Member, a person must apply and submit satisfactory evidence that they possess:

1. an educational post-graduate qualification in urban design with a minimum of 3 years urban design experience and have prepared a dissertation or case study. A person with urban design qualifications from academic institutes not located in Hong Kong is also required to sit for an Academic Qualifying Assessment; **and/or**
2. a post-graduate degree in a related professional field with, depending on the nature of the professional related field, between 5 to 10 years of urban design experience; **and** has successfully completed a Professional Induction Workshop conducted by HKIUD or its agent.

Any urban design experience must include a minimum of 1 year of experience in Hong Kong or the Asia Pacific region. Only continuous experience of over 6 months is eligible for counting.

If the evidence submitted is satisfactory to the membership committee, the applicant will be invited to an interview and upon completion of the interview, the membership committee shall make a recommendation to the General Council as to whether the applicant should be admitted as a Full Member. A person shall only be admitted as a Full Member upon endorsement by the General Council and upon satisfaction of any other requirements as may be prescribed by any membership guidelines.

Details of the dissertation or case study, the Academic Qualifying Assessment the related professional fields and the Professional Induction Workshop mentioned above are as prescribed under the appropriate membership guidelines.

**Graduate Members**

To be eligible to become a Graduate Member, a person must apply and submit satisfactory evidence that they possess an educational post-graduate qualification in urban design.

If the evidence submitted is satisfactory to the membership committee, the membership committee shall make a recommendation to the General Council as to whether the applicant should be admitted as a Graduate Member. A person shall only be admitted as a Graduate Member upon endorsement by the General Council and upon satisfaction of any other requirements as may be prescribed by the appropriate membership guidelines.

**Entrance Fee and Annual Subscriptions**

The Entrance Fees and Annual Subscriptions of Full Members, Associate Members, Non-resident Members, Graduate Members, and Student Members are as set out in the table below.
