In order to receive the views and comments from the public regarding the pedestrian and traffic environment in the Kowloon Bay Business Areas, there are three stages of Public Engagement (PE) throughout the study period. The Stages 1 & 2 PE events were completed in June 2013 and January 2014 respectively. The Energizing Kowloon East Office (EKEO) of Development Bureau (DevB) have analysed the views and suggestions given in the Stage 1 & Stage 2 PE. The results were summarized in the Executive Summaries which can be downloaded from the study website (www.ekeo.gov.hk/kbba-pedestrian). Having consolidated and considered the views from the public, together with other factors, the Study Team has modified the short to medium-term at-grade improvement proposals and formulated other medium to long-term improvement proposals. 
